JOB SUMMARY:

The job holder is responsible for the management and execution of the airport wildlife hazard management program at the George F.L Charles Airport

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Conducts runway inspections throughout the operating period of the airport, with a view to reporting to ATC/Airport Management the bird activity at the time of inspection.
- 2. Maintains a presence in the outfield to monitor/study the bird and wildlife activity.
- 3. Evaluates data/information derived from the monitoring, with a view to finding solutions to reduce bird and wildlife activity in around the airport.
- 4. Conducts runway inspection(s) immediately following the report of a bird strike.
- 5. Monitors ATC Ground/Aerodrome frequency, so as to employ rapid intervention whenever necessary.
- 6. Apprises ATC and /or Airport Management of any sighting of potential hazards likely to affect the safety of flight operations.
- 7. Removes FOD found on the Movement Area, dispose of in FOD bins and report on same in daily report.
- 8. Completes and sign a daily wildlife activity report after every shift. Ensure the report is reviewed and endorsed by Airport Management before dissemination.
- 9. Coordinates along with ATC, the submission of a Bird strike (BS) form to flight crew/airline, for completion by flight crew On receipt of a bird strike report.
- 10. Prepares and disseminates of Monthly/Annual reports on Airport wildlife and bird activity.
- 11. Maintains a filing system of all related wildlife and bird activity.
- 12. Employs various scare tactics during the runway inspection as necessary with the available tools
- 13. Employs fogging and other related activity, as needed with a view to reducing the presence of wildlife and birds at the airfield
- 14. Performs aerodrome inspections and Monitors pavement conditions
- 15. Conducts perimeter inspection with the aim of preventing wildlife entry
- 16. Performs any other related duties as assigned by the Supervisor from time to time
